Challenge

- Added external contact lists, internal procedures, and relevant schedules to an appendix, which could be easily updated as information changed.
- Prepared drafts for review by the outgoing and incoming facility managers to check for accuracy, address questions and suggestions, and provide other feedback.
- Incorporated all feedback for final approval and submitted the completed manual for client ownership.
